DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

1. INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO IFFCO, PHULPUR:

Under the aegis of Certificate Course in Environmental Awareness (CCEA-UGC, CPE-II) and Department of Chemistry, an industrial visit was organized to Indian Farmers and Fertilizer Cooperative Limited (IFFCO), Phulpur on 21st January, 2020. The one day visit was organized to give the students a feel of the organization and its working. 57 students of B.Sc. registered under CCEA participated in this educational trip.

Dr. H.M. Shukla (Manager, Bio-Fertilizer Unit, IFFCO) welcomed the students and gave an introduction of the inception of IFFCO. Dr. Shukla described the different activities of Cooperative Rural Development Trust (CORDET) of IFFCO in detail. CORDET is instrumental in demonstrating farming system models to increase the farm income by organizing various trainings and skill development programs for youth and women. He also explained the students about the IFFCO initiative "Save the Soil Campaign" with focus on soil rejuvenation and crop productivity enhancements for sustainable and environment friendly agriculture. Mr. Birendra Singh (Junior Assistant, Food Processing, IFFCO), briefed the students on crop production system, dairy, balanced fertilization, use of bio-fertilizers, beekeeping, pisciculture, fruits and vegetables preservation, etc. at the Phulpur Unit. The students enjoyed the technical endeavor at IFFCO and gave a very positive feedback. This visit seemed to be a very good learning experience and was very informative.


4. NATIONAL WEBINAR:




5. NATIONAL ONLINE QUIZ SERIES:



REPORT:

S. S. Khanna Girls' Degree College organized a 5 day international e-conference on "Sustainability Challenges and Transforming Opportunities amidst COVID-19' from 26.07.2020 to 30.07.2020 under the banner of Strengthening Component of Star College Scheme of Department of Biotechnology, Government of India.

The inaugural session of this conference was graced by the presence of Prof. A.K. Bakshi, Honorable Vice Chancellor of PDM University, Bahadurgarh, Haryana. Prof. Bakshi delivered a key note address on the topic "The Changing Phase of Higher Education in India: Challenges and Opportunities". In his address, he emphasized the importance of higher education and mentioned it as a driving force for social and economic growth, competitiveness and employment generation. On the first day of the conference, in the first technical session, Dr.

Sunaina Gowan from Australia emphasized that education is the ultimate mode to achieve 17 SDGs in this difficult time of the pandemic. The session was chaired by Prof. Dhananjay Yadav of University Of Allahabad, who told that education is the foundation for economic growth and overall human development. In the second technical session, the speaker was Dr. Sandeep K. Shukla, Quality Manager and Research Officer, Wain Ganga Water Quality Laboratory, Central Water Commission, Nagpur. The topic of his talk was "Water Quality Management: Effect on Water Quality Due To Lockdown". The session was chaired by Prof. Anil Kumar Bajpayee, Bose Memorial Research Lab, Department Of Chemistry, Government Autonomous Science College, Jabalpur. The third technical session was chaired by Prof. R.K. Singh, Department Of Chemistry and Controller of Examination, University Of Allahabad and the speaker in this session was Dr. Rajesh Kumar Singh, Laboratory Director of R&D, Albzyme Therpeutics, P.A., U.S.A. He delivered a talk on blooming topic of present scenario, "COVID-19 Pandemic and The USA". After his enlightening talk, Chairperson Dr. R.K. Singh conveyed the message on the importance of taking the necessary precautions during this time.

On the second day of the conference, in the first technical session, the chairperson was Prof. Ali Ahmed Fatmi, Former Head, Department Of Urdu and Prof. A.K. Bajpayee from Jabalpur. In this session, Dr. Sayed T.H. Abedi, Physician of the Scarborough Hospital Of Ontario, Canada gave a very informative talk on the topic, "How To Live With COVID-19: Preventions, Symptoms, Treatment and State Of Vaccine" Dr. Abedi clearly insisted to follow the principle, "Prevention Is Better Than Cure". The second technical session was chaired by Prf. R.K Srivastava, Head, Department of Environmental Science, University Of Allahabad. The speaker in this session was Dr. Felix Bast, Department of Botany, Central University of Punjab, Bhatinda. The topic of his talk was "SDG at a Personal Level: Transition towards Citizen of the Globe and Creature of Earth". Dr. Felix gave some useful tips to the participants s to how t practice sustainability t the personal level in their day to day lives by giving innumerable examples from his own life. The third technical session of oral presentation was chaired by Dr. Archana Pandey, Department Of Chemistry, C.M.P. Degree College and Dr. Sarita Srivastava, Department Of Botany, C.M.P. Degree College, Prayagraj. In this session, a total of 10 participants presented their papers out of which 3 papers were from outside of our country: Nizeria, France and Algeria. The judges of this session evaluated their presentations and for each of the sub-theme of the conference, the best paper was selected.

On the third day of the conference, the first technical session was chaired by Prof. Indira Mehrotra, Former Head, Department Of Physics, University Of Allahabad. In this session, Dr. Mohommad Rihan, Department Of Electrical Engineering, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh gave a very informative talk on the topic: "Sustainable Development Goals and Green Sources of Electric Energy". He told that from conventional sources of energy, emission of CO₂ is tremendous, therefore it is very essential to switch over to green energy sources. At last, the chairperson, Prof. Mehrotra, mentioned that green energy is sure, pure and secure and for this educators can play a big role. The second technical session was chaired by Prof. Namita Singh, Director, Department of Bio & Nano Technology, Guru Jambeshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar, Haryana. In this session, Dr. Namit Ranjan, Research Scientist, Department of Physical Biochemistry, Max Plank Institute for Biophysical Chemistry, Goltingen, Germany delivered a lecture on the topic, "Contribution of Basic Sciences in Disease Prevention". The third technical session of oral presentation was chaired by Dr. Anuja Saliya, Department of Education, Ishwar Sharan Degree College, Prayagraj and Dr. Kajal Deb,

Department of Education, Jagat Taran Degree College, Prayagraj. In this session, 12 participants presented their papers out of which one was from Canada.

On the fourth day of the conference, the first technical session was chaired by Prof. Shanthi Sundaram, Coordinator, Centre of Biotechnology, University Of Allahabad. In this session, Dr. Preen Prakash Yadav, Principal Scientist, Medicinal and Process Chemistry Division, CDRI Lucknow provided his insights on the topic, "Recent Advances in Drug Repurposing for Combating Sar-Cov-2". He very well explained that repurposing of many drugs has yielded good results to combat the disease. The second technical session of oral presentation was chaired by Dr. Neerja Kapoor, Department of Zoology, C.M.P. Degree College, Prayagraj and Dr. Justin Masih, Ewing Christian College, Prayagraj. In this session, total 13 papers were presented out of which one paper was from Algeria. In the third session, Mr. Thomas P. Valenti, Conflict Resolution Specialist, Chicago II, U.S.A., delivered a lecture on the topic, "Alternative Dispute Resolution in the COVID-19 Era" under the theme legal sustainability. The distinguished speaker outlined the various forms of Alternative Dispute Resolution and explained that how it is more desirable than the traditional justice system. The session was chaired by Prof. Shakeel Sandani, Dean, Faculty of Law, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh. The fourth technical session was chaired by Prof. Ashish Saxena, Head, Department of Sociology, University of Allahabad. In this session, Dr. Unnat P. Pandit, Professor of IP, Innovation & Entrepreneurship, Jawaharlal Nehru University and Former Director, Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, New Delhi delivered a talk on the topic, "Atmnirbhar Bharat: Role of Youth in Societal Transformation". In his talk, he explained that this transformation can only be brought about by start-ups in education imparting through skills and strengthening the innovation ecosystem in India according to the global trend and trade.

On the fifth day of the conference, in the first technical session, Prof. S.G. Venkat Subramaniyam, Environment & Law Management, Anna University, Chennai delivered a talk on the topic, "The Role of Legal Regime in India and the International Level: Its Effectiveness for the Sustenance of Sustainable Development". He discussed various environmental laws and articles. The session was chaired by Prof. Prahlad Kumar, Former Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Former Head, Department of Economics, University of Allahabad. In the second technical session, Dr. Tarun Arora, Professor, Department of Law, Dean, School of Legal Studies, Central University of Punjab, Bhatinda delivered a talk on the topic, "Sustainable Development Goals, Constitutional Values and Environmental Education". He talked about India's contribution towards environment protection. In the third technical session of oral presentation, the chairperson was Dr. Sushma Sharma, National Law University, Bhopal. In this session, total 5 participants presented their papers on socio-economic and legal sustainability.

Valedictory Session of this conference was graced by the presence of Prof. K.V. Bhanu Murti, Former Dean, Faculty of Commerce, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi as the chief guest. Prof. Murti delivered a very informative talk on the topic, "Climate Change, Sustainability and Poverty".

Some important conclusions which we derived from this conference were:

- 1. In this time of the pandemic, we have entered into a digital age where electricity is a necessity. So, we need to rapidly switch over to green energy sources.
- 2. For health sustainability, we must follow the principle, "Precaution Is Better than Cure". Also, repurposing of drugs can be very useful to combat the disease.
- 3. Socio-economic sustainability can be seen making a breakthrough in combating profit with sustainability values using 5 elements: Water, Energy, Waste, Ecology & Food.

- 4. For educational sustainability, use of ICT should be emphasized in education, especially in higher education. The new education policy will have far reaching effects on higher education.
- 5. For legal sustainability, actions should be taken against fake news and the required laws should be implemented.

The conference was enriched with nuts of intellect and inspiration by the presence of experts from various diverse fields comprising of the Vice Chancellor, Directors, Doctors, Professors, Eminent Scientists, Legal Experts and experts of various other fields. Participation of 260 scholars from 7 foreign countries: France, Canada, Australia, USA, Germany, Algeria, and Nigeria, and from each and every state of India gave this conference a new height.

7. GUEST LECTURE:

Under strengthening component of star college scheme of DBT, Department of Chemistry of S. S. The session was coordinated by the organizing secretary Dr. Sarita Agrawal.




4. National Online Quiz On "Immunity And Covid-19"


