On 12.04.2018, a special lecture was organized by the Ancient History Department of Our college. The theme of the lecture was **PROF.B N S YADAV'S APPROACH IN HISTORY WRITING**. The eminent speaker on the topic was **PROF. OM PRAKASH SHRIVASTAVA (Retired Professor) the UNIVERSITY OF ALLAHABAD**. Professor Srivastava, in his lecture, while introducing the socio-economic history of ancient India, the book of Brijnath Singh Yadav, said that this composition of Yadav ji is like an ocean in a Gagar for the knowledge of the socio-economic history of the pre-medieval period.. Between 600 to 1200 AD, he discussed the contribution of Professor Yadav in history writing of feudalism, category, Vishti, agriculture, Karshak, Halik, trade commerce, slavery, aapdharma etc. Yadav ji's contribution is outstanding.
