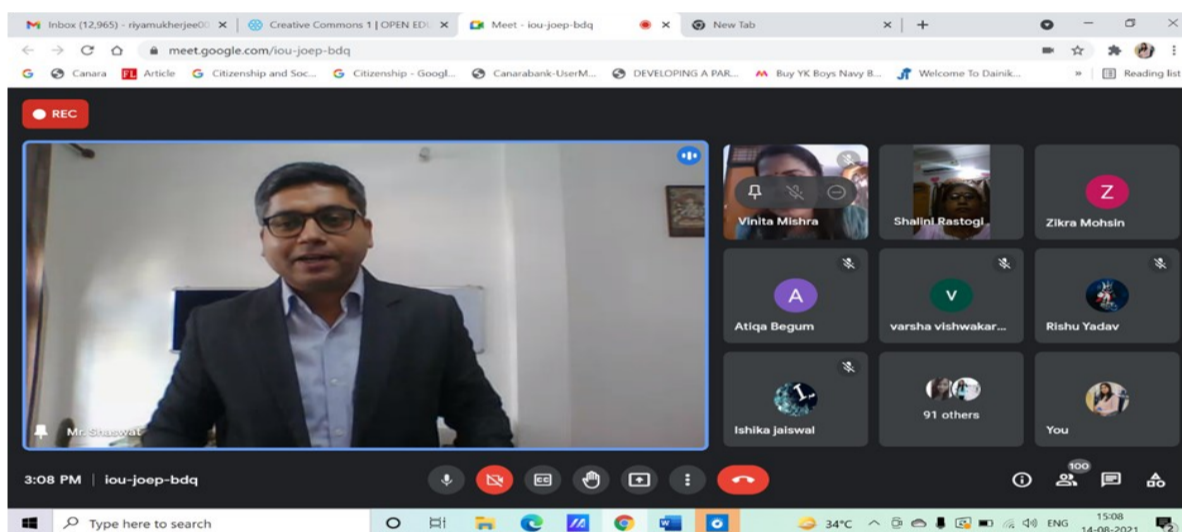

Self-Driven Activity
Deliberation by Placement Cell on 14.08.2021,
topic: “Thinking Careers Outside the Box”

Resource Person: Dr. Shaswat Mishra, Placement Officer, University of Allahabad

Objective of the Talk: The talk will focus on rethinking the prospects of careers which move away from the traditional mode of shaping careers. The talk will focus on the factors that influence career choices, and how can those factors be mobilised to think about career differently. The talk will focus on how to innovate careers by bringing in entrepreneurship to shape careers. The importance of entrepreneurship as a mode of shaping careers will be an important aspect of this lecture. The talk will also enable the students to think of things like their true calling. The talk will also focus on nuances of establishing businesses/start-ups like value creation, allied services, unique business opportunities, DIY (Do It Yourself), intimate the students about internships in start-ups, portals like start-up India, and how to create contacts and mentors in those sites, alternatives in the Gig Economy (DIY) like markets and marketing, techno turners, lucky linguists or about schemes like ‘learn while you earn’.

Expected Outcome of the Talk: The talk would encourage students to think about their careers in a different light. The students attending the programme would be able to think of entrepreneurship in an exceptional way, and may be even be urged to rethink their decision to get into established jobs. Students will also be able to learn from the experience of the speaker himself, and focus more on innovation in every aspect of their life. The talk will also motivate them to restructure and innovate their traditional career choices, and bring in innovation in even the minutest activities they are indulging in like edtech, online tutoring etc. The ideas associated with creating start-ups might help the students understand the nuances of creating start-ups which will encourage them to test their ideas. The students would also learn the basics of entrepreneurship and also the means of getting funded for start-ups or small vendoring.

Premchand Jayanti: 31.07.2021

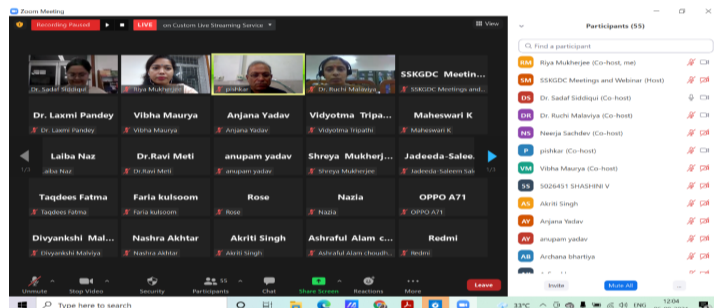
