It was decided that Dr. Rahman will assist the Principal in the matter.

Resolution No. 8:

- Members were informed that AQAR of the session 2020-21 had been prepared. The future action plan for the academic session 2021-22 was also discussed. Members gave their consent for its uploading after incorporating following future action plan:
 - Establishment of an Incubation Cell in the college under the ambit of IIC. Prof. Sundaram offered assistance in setting up of this cell.
 - ❖ 25-30 LED rods would be installed in the library under the green energy practices.
 - Making the facility of e-library more effective for the students
 - Improving the rain-water harvesting facility of the college by extending it in the new building
 - Installation of solar panels
 - More proposals for add-on courses would be invited
 - Increasing the lab-space for Botany, Chemistry and Zoology.
 - Additional space would be allocated to the Faculty of B.Ed.
 - Organising more national and International Seminar/Webinars.

- An International Poetry Festival to be organized by the Department of English in collaboration with the Waymade college of Education.
- Establishment of Common Instrumentation facility (lab) for science faculty

Resolution No. 9:

• The mentor-mentee policy document was discussed. It was resolved that mentors will have a discussion with the mentees to identify their desirous revisions in the curriculum, to locate the redundant elements, extra-curricular activities desired by them, research-related improvements that they are desirous of.
