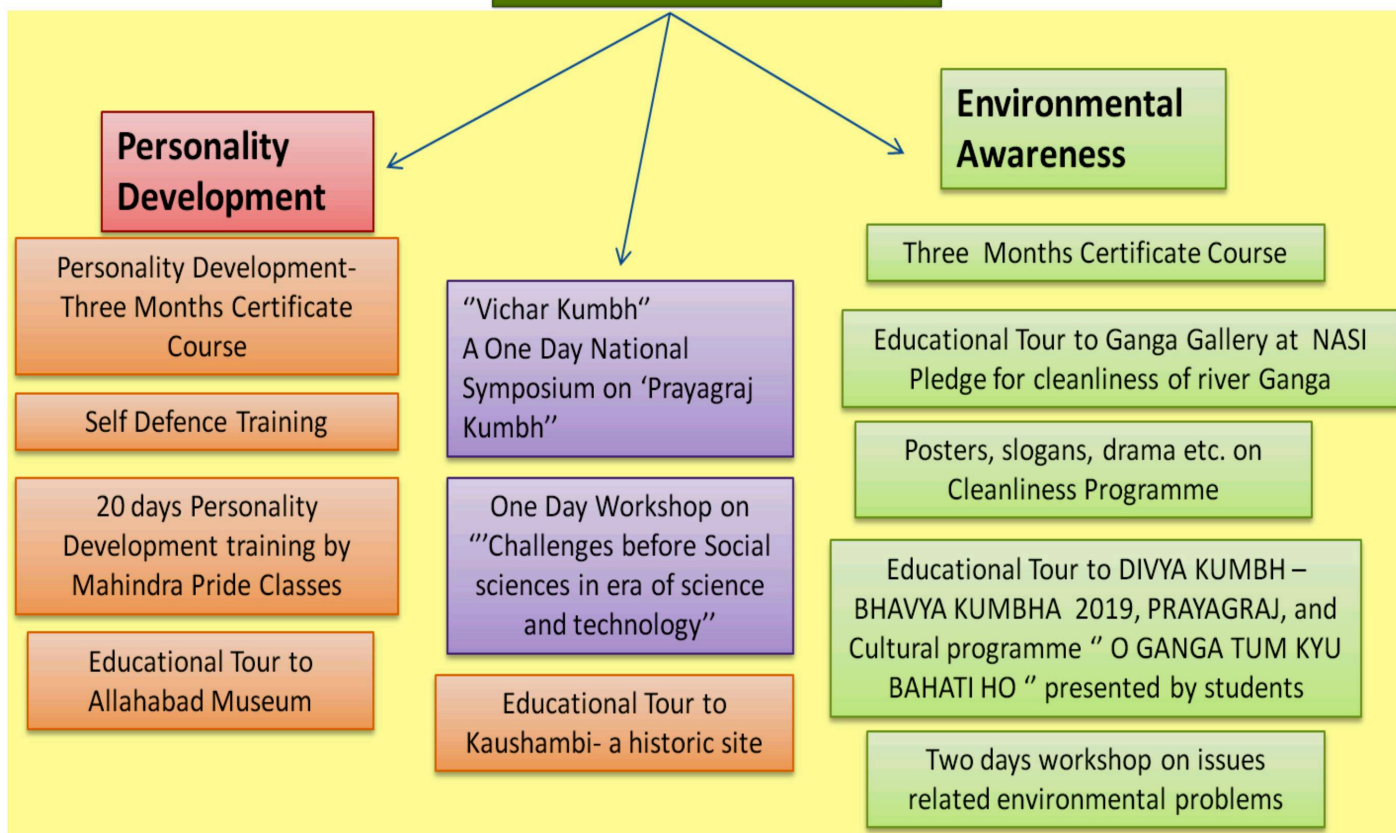
**College With Potential for Excellence, Phase II**

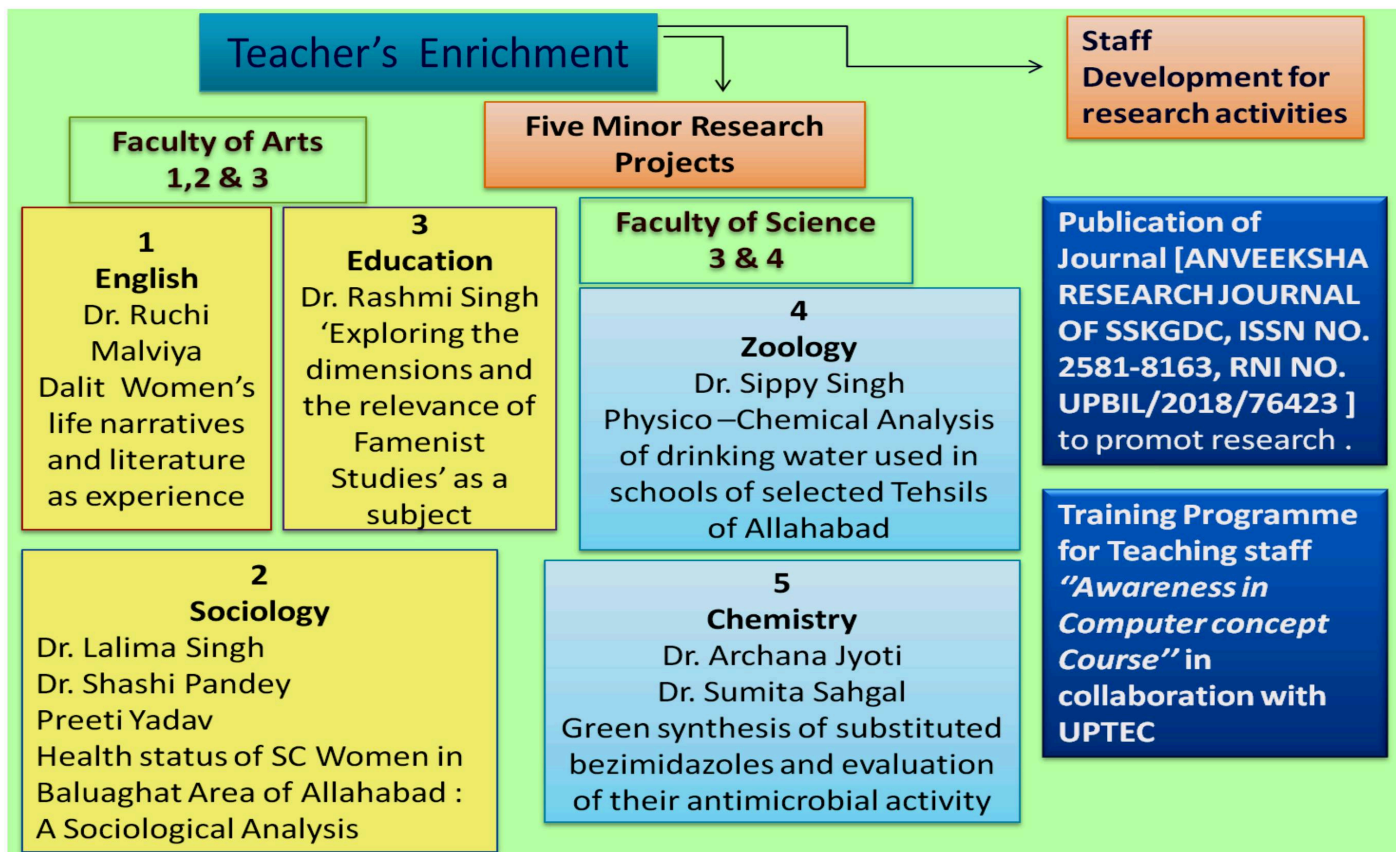

Rajarshi Tandon Open University, Prayagraj. The special invitee of the event was research scholar Ms. Tomoka Mushiga from Japan. Ms. Tomoka gave a detailed description of the *kalpvashis* in Kumbh mela and laid stress that there is a difference

between what we preach and what we practice. Prof. K.N. Singh said lifestyle is determined according to the geography of the place. On 19<sup>th</sup> November 2018, a one day workshop was organized on "Challenges before Social Sciences in Era of Science and



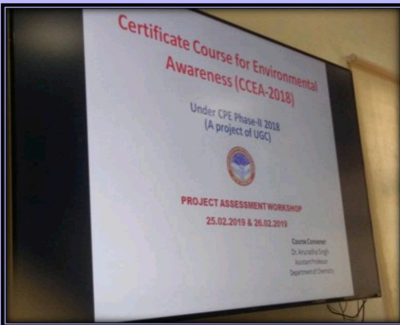

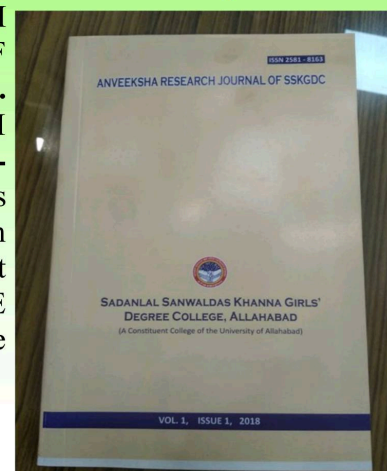
