The college starting with humble beginning in 1975 and today is a premier constituent college of the University of Allahabad. The college has five faculties: Arts, Science, Commerce, B.Ed and Legal Studies. During the XIIth Plan period, the University Grants Commission conferred the college status of "College with Potential for Excellence (CPE)".

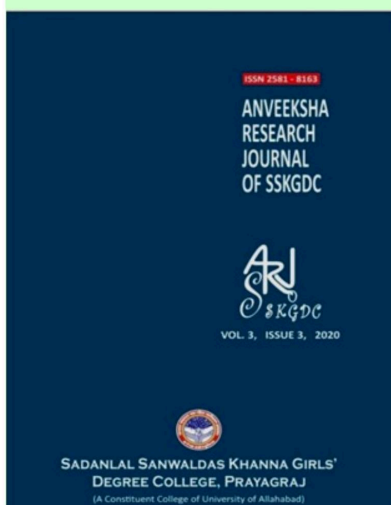

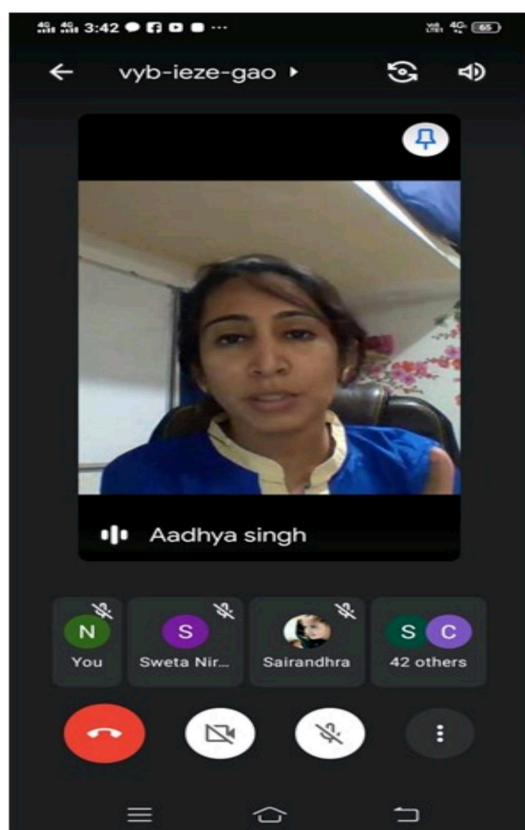
## Three day lecture series on IPR

A three days lecture series on Intellectual Property Rights was organised by the IPR Cell of the institution. The eminent speakers in the workshop were **Dr Vibhuti Tripathi, School of Management Studies, MNNIT Prayagraj, Dr Madhvendra Misra, Dept. of Management Studies, IIIT, Prayagraj and Dr. Amit Prabhakar, Faculty incharge IPR, IIIT, Prayagraj.**

**On the day 1** of the lecture series, Dr Vibhuti Tripathi, School of Management Studies, MNNIT, Prayagraj, focussed on Copyright Infringement and Plagiarism: Types and avoidance. The speaker made the audience aware of the concepts of Copyright Infringement and Plagiarism and stressed that the faculty and researchers should develop the thinking and writing capability.

**On the day 2** of the lecture series, Dr. Amit Prabhakar, Faculty incharge IPR, IIIT, delivered a lecture on Patents and the Patenting Process. He emphasised on the role patents play in researches and business transactions, examining the strategies and advantages/disadvantages of patent protection.

**On the third day** of the lecture series Dr Madhvendra Misra, Dept. of Management Studies, IIIT, delivered a lecture on ethics in academic research and writing. He explained the concept of Ethical writing as writing with a level of inclusion, respect, and acknowledgment of diversity. He emphasized that the importance of ethical writing is based not only upon the avoidance of plagiarism, but also avoiding the weaknesses of bias and exclusive language which thereby strengthens the credibility and persuasiveness of the writer's argument.

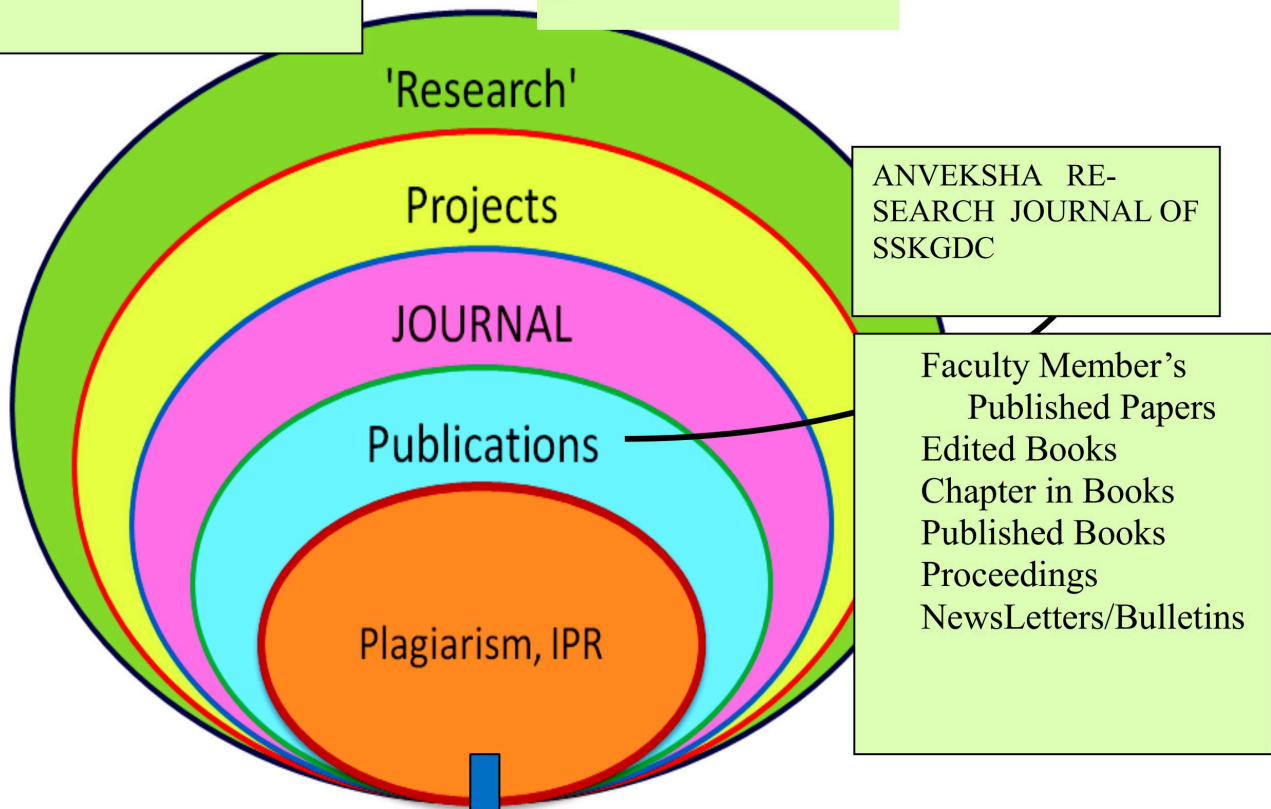
#### Some Other Action Taken:

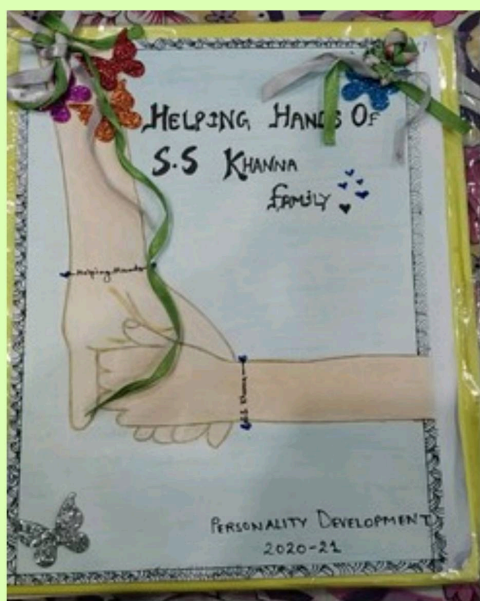

The necessity of an **Orientation programme on Soft Skills, Campus Interviews & Personality Enhancement** is quite evident, as it is generally seen that the degrees and diplomas fall short of providing the students with good jobs even at the start-up level due to lack of soft skills and professional grooming. Keeping in view the above mentioned fact it is imperative that the students be imparted effective theoretical and practical training on **‘Soft Skills, Interviews and Personality Grooming’**. This besides enhancing the employability of the students would further enhance the potential of an Institution to reach higher realms of excellence. In furtherance of the above an orientation programme on **‘Soft Skills, Interviews and Personality Grooming’** being the need of the hour was emphasised and conducted at the **S.S.Khanna Girls PG College, Allahabad** giving the students the right opportunity at the right time, and at the right place.

**1. Making soft skills your core strength :** It is all about the ability to deal with people hence an overview on how to acquire soft skills and its importance was effectively dealt with.

**2. Resume and Cover Letter :** The face of the corporate world and the way business is conducted has drastically changed during the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. Likewise, the level of competition in Job market has risen exponentially. *The programme was intended to* guide the students through the daunting process of compiling ALL of the resume data, organizing it, and finally properly packaging it. *The training programme analyzed* all popular formats and showing you how to choose the most effective one—the one that will get you the interview call. Students were guided on how to stitch a tailor-made effective Resume in order to get an interview call. They were informed about the importance of an effective Resume

**Effective Interview Techniques :** Students were given various tips on Interview Etiquettes and Techniques and were informed about the questions one may encounter during the interview, in one form or another. These relate to questions **about yourself, what you have been doing and what you want to do in future.**

**4. Group Discussion :** A detailed session was conducted on the students to give them the real feel and how carry yourself in a Group Discussion and the expected questions were dealt at great length with the possible answers for the benefit of the students.

**5. Dress code, Body language and Gestures :** Proper dress code for interview, difference between formal and informal was discussed in detail besides proper hygiene, use of effective and positive body language and gestures and interview etiquettes.

**6. Self- Confidence :** The programme ended with an advice on how to be confident and how to remain so throughout your life, how to choose a positive thought, how to set your goals and how to be an achiever.

Lastly it will not be out of place to mention that the student response and the feedback was excellent.

Science practicals are one of the fundamental tools enabling the students both to learn scientific knowledge, as well as have huge significance in the learning process. It engages students, helping them to develop important skills, understand the process of scientific investigation and develop a broad understanding of scientific concepts. Practical work has its clear benefits, helping students to acquire the essential skills that not only give a fluid transition to higher-study, but open the doors to science as a profession.

Saroj Lalji Mehrotra science Faculty has always strived for providing better science education to the students. In succession to that the grants sanctioned to the College from UGC under CPE phase II have been utilized to establish better infrastructure in the faculty of science. The three departments from the faculty viz., Chemistry, Botany and Zoology have been provided the grant to upgrade their lab facilities as well as the funding of minor research projects in the department of Chemistry and Zoology. This year the grant was utilized to procure consumables in the form of glassware and chemicals in the three aforementioned departments to provide better scientific facilities to the students as well as to promote research in the faculty.

### **ICT based teaching through LMS, Google Meet, Zoom, Lecture Recording Recording**

The institution has adopted learning management system G-Suite and Google Classroom which enables teachers to set up a digital space for their classroom where students can submit assignments, collaborate and share feedback, and keep all their work organized in one place. This LMS creates opportunities to teach students in a virtual mode, to think beyond the limits of paper, pencil, and textbook and learn to leverage the digital tools at their disposal. It is a vehicle for digital endeavours and a good way to teach digital literacy, or the ability to use technology in a meaningful and resourceful way.

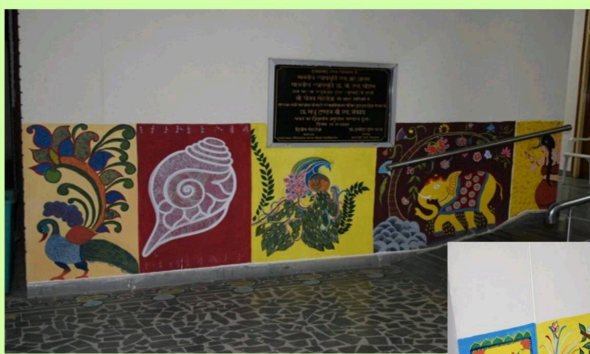
- Cleaning products containing soap or detergent to reduce germs were purchased.
