Anti Ragging Cell

S. S. Khanna Girls' Degree College has been following a 'Zero Tolerance' policy against ragging since its commencement. Each student of the college is required to fill an online anti ragging undertaking (www.antiragging.in) in the form of an affidavit at the time of admission in the format prescribed by UGC and has to provide the reference number to the prescribed email id of the Nodal officer of the college, this process is mandatory for admission.

After admission process is completed an interactive session is organized with the students of each faculty to make them aware of the anti-ragging rules and regulation laid down by the UGC as well as the existence and the functioning if the anti – ragging cell.

Objective of the cell:

 To eliminate ragging in all its forms from our institution by prohibiting it under these Regulations, preventing its occurrence and punishing those who indulge in ragging as provided for in these Regulations and the appropriate law in force.

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts as listed in the UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.

- > Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- > Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Disciplinary actions may be taken by the college in case of ragging:

Depending upon the gravity of the offence as established by the antiragging cell of the college, the punishment for those found guilty of ragging shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- ❖ Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, etc.
- Cancellation of admission.

What should be donein case of any ragging incident?

Anti-ragging cell has installed drop-boxes in each faculty so that students may drop their complaints regarding ragging if they have any. The complaints will be brought before the members of the cell in the meeting. Besides this in case of any ragging incident, the students can immediately call or send an e-mail and bring it to the notice of the concerned authorities for necessary help, guidance and action.
