



#### **Development of Microalgal Fortified Food Products and Food Supplements**

The deterioration of the ecological status of urban areas and the industrialization of the food industry requires the additional enrichment of the diet with biologically valuable food substances. According to government data Over 33 lakh children in India malnourished, 17.7 lakh of them severely malnourished: Govt data. (07-Nov-2021). So, we have to shift our usual diet towards Natural product. Proposed idea refers to a range of innovative fusion food cuisines with fresh algal biomass which will enhance the nutritional worth of our existing diets. So, we have focussed on natural product as microalgae. Algae is a photosynthetic, oxygenexhaling, unicellular, or multicellular microorganism with diverse characteristics such as consumption of carbon dioxide and storage of essential nutrients, minerals, and vitamins. Requiring only water and sunlight to grow, algae have long been looked to as a potential source of food. They are low in calories, contain highquality protein and many carbohydrates (polysaccharides), especially dietary fibres. Among the most used microalgae are Chlorella and Spirulina, in addition, Dunaliella, Haematococcus, Schizochytrium, Scenedesmus, Aphanizomenon, Odontella, and Porphyridium are gaining acceptance in the food and health-food market. The proposed smart algal food idea will provide antioxidants, vitamins, minerals and other nutrients in order to meet our body's need in the best way possible. Algae possess properties that make them useful to be incorporated in diversified end products such as Ice-creams, Cookies, Candies, Chocolate, Algae Protein Powder etc. As nutritional composition varies tremendously among algal species, and even within the same species, nutritional content can vary significantly based on the growth environment, both the media composition as well as temperature and light regime. For example, the immune system improvement in the case of Chlorella, the prevention and treatment of heart diseases with the Spirulina, Vitamin A precursor (Dunaliella), anti-inflammatory (Haematococcus), treatment of brain and heart disorders (Schizochytrium), and so on.
