

## Divyangjan Policy

## S.S. Khanna Girls' P. G. College, Prayagraj

S.S. Khanna Girls' P. G. College, a pioneer in women education also aims to provide due attention to persons with disabilities under the provisions of The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act. 2016. The institution recognises the needs of the divyangjan women learners and therefore takes necessary measures to make the infrastructure and the programmes accessible to all.

## Policy for Divyangjan

- The Institution follows the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 of the Government of India, which prohibits discrimination against individuals with physical and mental disabilities
- 2) The College aims at making the institution friendly for disabled students.
- 3) The College strives to extend a helping hand towards the differently abled students in order to ensure accessibility of education and the benefits thereof in an inclusive and amicable atmosphere.

#### Objectives

- Create an environment that avoids discrimination and exploitation of disabled students or staff in all spheres of work and education.
- To ensure implementation of all government legislations with respect to Divyangjan
- To ensure maximum participation of persons with disabilities and at the same time provide them the equal opportunity for development
- 4) To channelise their talents and skills in the appropriate direction and provide them with best of opportunities so that they succeed in their career.

#### Provisions with regard to Admission

- (i) As per section 32(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, all Government institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five( 05) per cent seats for person with benchmark disabilities. Therefore 5% of total seats for this course will be available for person with disability who can pursue this course without any difficulty.
- (ii) A candidate who has a certified disability of not less than 40 % in any limb or in orthopaedic structure which, in the opinion of the Medical Board (constituted by the University of Allahabad), amounts to an overall physical handicap of not more than 70% or is a certified Visually impaired or a Hearing impaired, may be admitted to the concerned course / subject, irrespective of his position in the order of merit of the total aggregate score, on the recommendation of the Medical Board.
- Seats under this quota shall be filled in order of preference given below. One percent each shall be reserved for person with benchmark disability under clause (a). (b) and (c), and one percent with benchmark disability under clauses (d) and (e) namely. a. Blindness and low vision. b. Deaf and hard of

hearing. c. Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy. d. Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness. e. Multiple disabilities from amongst person from clauses (a) to (d).

- (iv) The privilege shall not be given except claimed by the candidate at the time of application. At the time of admission the candidate shall be required to produce a certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the appropriate District or by the Viklang Kendra, Allahabad, which testifies to his disability and bears an attested photograph indicating his / her disability clearly.
- (v) All candidates entitled to be admitted under the above quota to a course shall be adjusted against their respective social category.

# Scholarship for Differently Abled Students

- Government scholarship

The College provides "Dr. Madhu Tandon Memorial Fee Reimbursement Scheme" "Shrimati Shakuntla Chopra Memorial Scholarship" for PwD students.

#### Infrastructural Facilities

- The College has two lifts in two different blocks, one in Science Faculty and the other in Arts Faculty which facilitates the movement of the PWD students on all floors of the building.
- The College has ramps at various places located in different buildings of the College

- The College provides for 5% reservation of seats for admission to PWD candidates.
- The College provides scribes for writing to those students who require the facility.

- Speech-to-text facility (Google Voice Typing), Windows Speech Recognition (in-built tool on Windows) and Dictate (in Office 365) for motor impaired students
