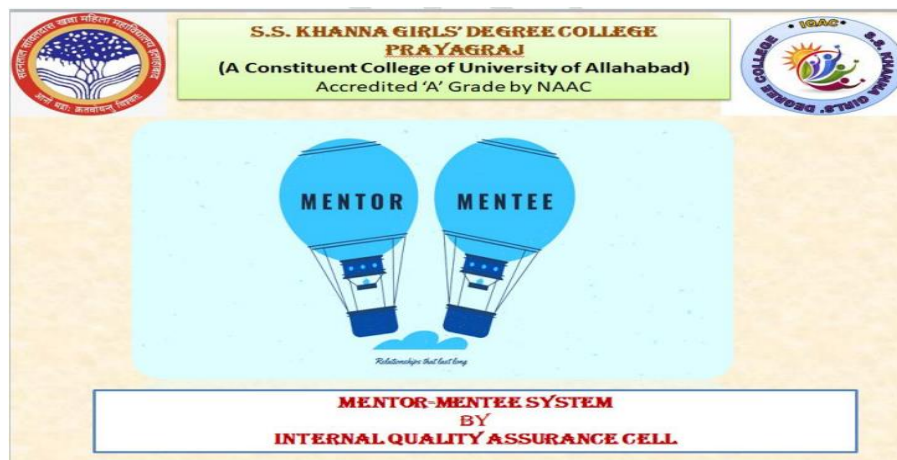

A Special lecture on 'Values and Ethics' was organized by IQAC of the College for Undergraduate Final Year students on 02nd August, 2022. In order to sensitize students towards the importance of values and ethics in life, IQAC Coordinator Dr. Manjari Shukla, Associate Professor, Department of Philosophy addressed the gathering. She explained four different phases of life and highlighted the relative importance of each phase. Dr. Shukla emphasized the importance of self-discipline, respect for others, concentration, patience, diligence and humility in life of a student. Further she explained the significance of ethical behavior in achieving the goal of life. Dr. Shukla briefed the students about the meaning of the vision of the college and narrated the story behind the word UBUNTU (Vision of the college). She further highlighted the major points of code of conduct to be observed by the students such as discipline, dress code, punctuality etc. 138 students attended the lecture.



## ➤ One Day Workshop on Mentor-Mentee System

A one-day workshop was organized by IQAC for faculty members on Mentor-Mentee System on 23rd August 2022. All faculty members participated in the workshop. IQAC coordinator Dr. Manjari Shukla apprised the faculty members about the system of mentor-mentees. She explained in detail about the objectives, expected outcomes, roles and responsibilities of mentors. She also described the line of reporting and clarified the role of mentor core committee. It was also conveyed to the faculty members that each mentor should keep the details of their mentees in the prescribed format and mentees must also be made aware about their roles and responsibilities. At the end of the academic session, mentor will prepare the report card of mentee. Mentees will also provide feedback about the mentors which will be recorded by the mentor core committee. It was also informed to the faculty members that Dr. Harish Kumar Singh of Department of Education is the in-charge of mentor core committee. He also explained about the procedure of maintaining mentee details and other information. At the end of the workshop, mentees were allocated to the mentors.

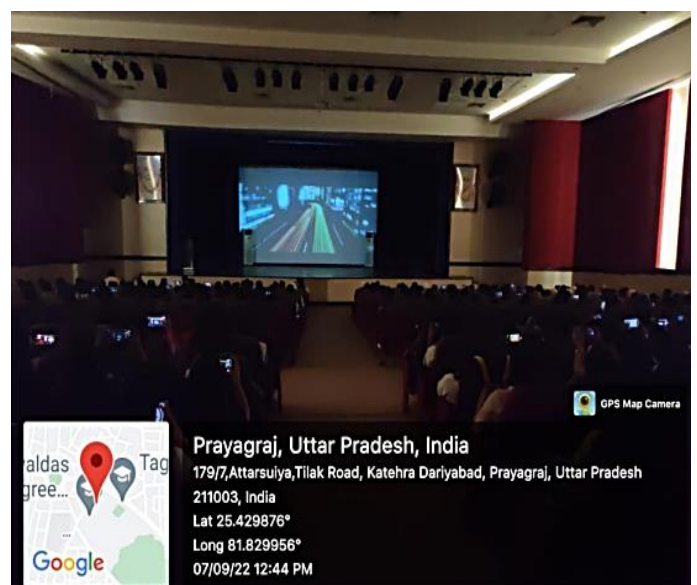


## ➤ Film Screening by IQAC

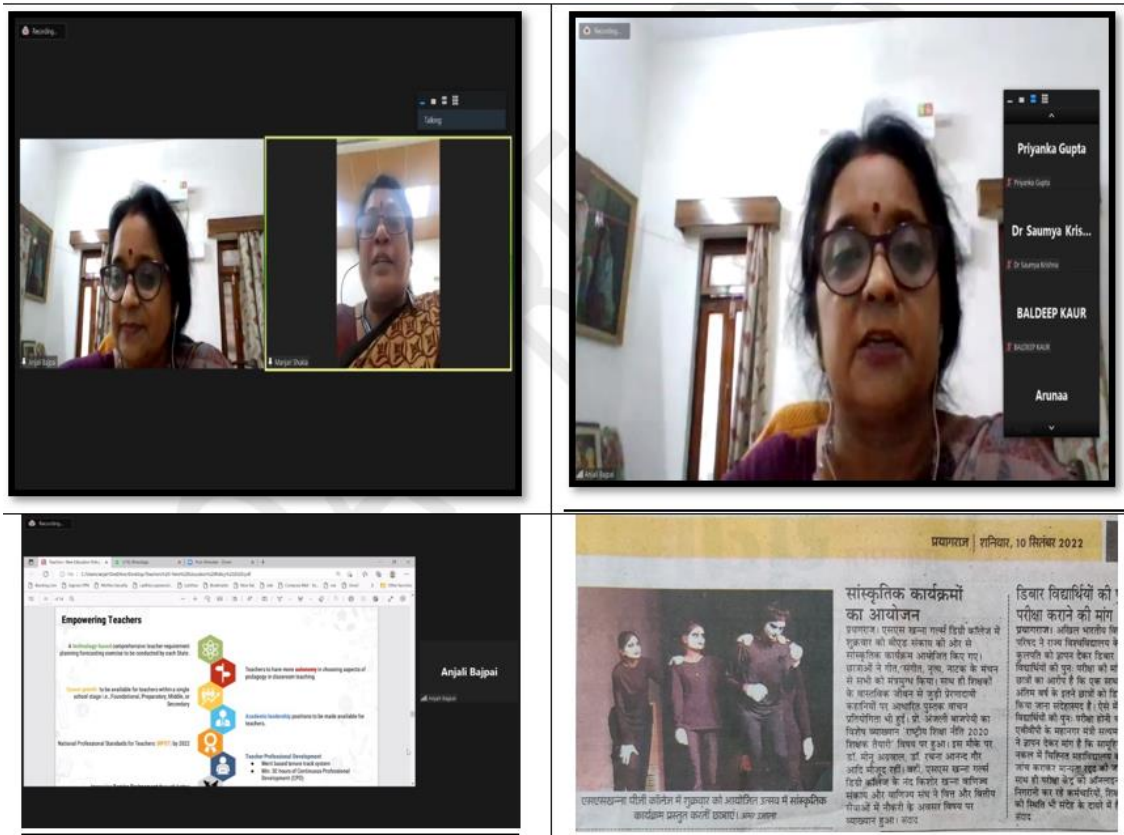
As per the directive of UGC (Letter No: D.O. No. 2-79/2022(CPP-II) dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022), the IQAC of College organized a special lecture in online mode on the topic of “Teachers Preparation As in NEP 2020” on 9<sup>th</sup> September 2022 as a part of series of celebration of ‘*Shikshak Parv*’.

The special lecture was delivered by Prof. Anjali Bajpai, Department of Education, Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. This lecture was organized exclusively for the faculty members of the college.

In her deliberation, Prof. Bajpai explained those significant points of NEP 2020 upon which faculty members need to pay special attention. She described in detail that how the role of teachers is going to be changed after implementation of NEP 2020. She also discussed the difference between 1 year B.Ed., 2 year B.Ed. and 4 year Integrated B.Ed. course. She also discussed about the ways to improve teacher education such as:

- All teacher education programmes to be conducted within composite multidisciplinary institutions
- New and comprehensive National Curriculum Framework for Teacher Education
- NTA testing for admission to B.Ed.
- Merit based scholarship for 4 year B.Ed. Integrated course
- Only educationally sound, multidisciplinary and integrated teacher education programmes to be made available
- Stringent action against sub-standard stand-alone Teacher Education Institutions
- Setting up of National Mission for mentoring with a large pool of outstanding senior/retired faculty’

She also discussed about the various means and ways to empower teachers. The resource person was welcomed by the Principal Prof. Lalima Singh and vote of thanks was proposed by IQAC coordinator Dr. Manjari Shukla.

The main speaker of this workshop was Shri R.K. Vishwakarma, Registrar Nehru Gram Bharti Deemed University, Prayagraj. All the non-teaching staff of the college had participated in this workshop and were benefitted from it.

Shri R. L. Vishwakarma talked about the utility of employees in any educational institution. He insisted on using the term 'Administrative Cadre' in place of non-teaching staff and explained about the values and ethics of the administrative cadre at any work place. Mr. Vishwakarma said that the development of any institution depends on the ethical values of the administrative cadre based on human values like good conduct, truth, love, peace, moral values, logical values, and aesthetic values and human values.

He also talked about the classification of administrative cadre in higher education. Along with this, he also mentioned in detail about the written and unwritten contribution of administrative cadre in higher education. He discussed about the various rules, regulation, office order, and memorandum etc. issued by the institution and other regulating bodies.

At the end of the workshop, the question session was organized for the employees and their problems were solved.

A workshop on “Values and Ethics of Teaching Staff at Workplace in Academic Institution” was organized by IQAC of the College exclusively for its faculty members on 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2023. The resource person of this workshop was Prof. Alka Agrawal (Retd.), Former Dean CDC, University of Allahabad. She was also the former Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Former Head, Department of Economics, University of Allahabad.

She highlighted the quality, value and ethics of education. She said that the quality of education depends on the teacher's perseverance, work dedication, understanding of the subject, and commitment towards the development of the students. In order to prepare the students for the global level in the changing scenario, teachers also need to bring changes in

themselves. To be loyal to one's work is the greatest morality and, in this direction, discretion is the ultimate guide.

Her deliberation was mainly focused on three aspects; quality in education, values and ethics. She emphasized that quality depends upon dedication and intensity with which one works. She said that if the teacher does his or her work with passion then obviously it will evoke interest among the students. Joy of teaching is the crux of quality. There may be times when there is conflict between quality and values. Conscience is the ultimate guide to deal with such situations. "Do Justice to Your Job" is the key to maintain a balance between Quality, Values and Ethics.

58 teachers of the college participated in the workshop. Principal, Prof Lalima Singh welcomed the resource person and vote of thanks was proposed by IQAC coordinator, Dr. Manjari Shukla.

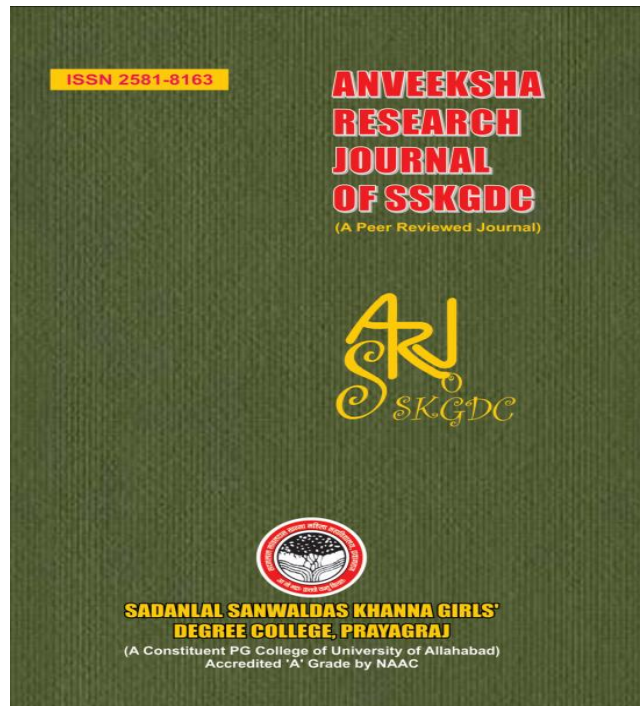
## ➤ Summer Coaching 2022

A month-long free offline summer coaching programme was inaugurated on 01.06.2022. The programme continued till the 30<sup>th</sup> of June, 2022 and covered all important topics requisite for the above-mentioned examinations. The programme received an overwhelming response with 426 registrations and was conducted in the offline mode. For an unhindered communication and discussion among the students and faculty members a Telegram Group was also created. 49 teachers of the college contributed to this programme. At the end of the coaching a quiz was conducted to test the benefit reaped by the students in participating in the coaching programme, and certificates were issued to the students who secured 40% or more.
