Rules & Regulations

SELF-COMPOSED POETRY

(HINDI/ENGLISH/ SANSKRIT/URDU)

- Only 3 participants (of each language) approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate.
- The subject of the composition should not be controversial. It should not hurt the sentiments of anyone belonging to any religion or caste.
- Each candidate will get **5 minutes to present** their self-composed poetry. All the other rules shall be told by the organizers on the day of the event.

GROUP FOLK SINGING, GROUP FOLK DANCE & SOLO TABLA PLAYING COMPETITION.

- Only one team from each institution approved by their respective authority, comprising of maximum 6 to 8 contestants (folk song and folk dance) along with the accompanist, will be allowed.
- For Tabla Competition, only 2 solo participants will be allowed.
- 5 minutes will be given to each team/participant.
- All contestants will have to bring their own musical instruments and no traveling allowance is payable for the same.
- Only Live Singing and Live Music will be allowed for both Folk Singing and Folk Dance.
- Karaoke or recorded in background music as accompaniment will be disqualified.
- E-music instrument will not be allowed.

QUIZ COMPETITION

- Only one team of 2 participants approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate.
- There will be 5 Rounds in this Competition, namely:
ROUND-1 (General Round)
ROUND-2 (Buzzer Round)
ROUND-3 (Specialized Subject)
ROUND-4 (Personality Identification Round)
ROUND-5 (Rapid fire round)
- Rules and regulations of each round will be told on the day of the competition.
- Question & Answer will be bilingual.

ESSAY WRITING

(HINDI/ENGLISH/ SANSKRIT/URDU)

- Only 3 participants (of each language) approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate.
- The participants have to **bring plain A4 size sheet only** and their own stationery.
- The essay should be within the **word limit of 1000-1200 words**. The essay should not be controversial and should not hurt the sentiments of any person of any religion or caste.
- The participants will be given **1 hour to write the essay on the spot**.

VIDEO MAKING COMPETITION

- Only 3 participants approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate. They can either participate as a team of two or as an individual.
- Participants are required to provisionally register themselves through this link <https://forms.gle/UhkXV8t99rUjz3rPA> by sharing their details and uploading the video made by them by **20.12.2023**.
- Participants must create a self-shot or animated video on the given **topic**. The video must be no longer than **5 minutes in duration**. The participant can use either Hindi or English to Voice-over his / her video.
- The video must be submitted in **MP4 format** with a resolution of **360p** and a file size not exceeding **25 MB**. The video must adhere to the **16:9** aspect ratio
- Only 10 shortlisted participants will be called on the day of the competition for presentation. They will have to present a brief introduction of 1 minute either in Hindi or English following which their video will be displayed.
- Entries that address controversial topics or may offend the sensibilities of others will be disqualified.

GEOGRAPHY MODEL COMPETITION

- Only a team of 3 participants approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate.
- Each team needs to submit an abstract about the model, which they are planning to build for the competition.
- Self-explanatory poster of the working / Non-working model has to be presented on the day of the competition.
- The model should be related to Geography.

PLEASE NOTE

- Only students of graduate/postgraduate can participate in the competitions of Gyanotsav.
- It is mandatory for every participant to come with the institution identity card.
- In each competition, the decision of the Judges shall be final and irrevocable.

SCIENCE MODEL COMPETITION

- Only a team of 3 participants approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate.
- Each team needs to submit an abstract about the model, which they are planning to build for the competition.
- Self-explanatory poster of the Working/Non-working model has to be presented on the day of the competition.
- The model should be related to Science. Marking Scheme will be as follows :
 - Selection of Model [20 Points]
 - Explanation of the model [25 Points]
 - Design and fabrication [30 Points]
 - Aesthetic appeal [25 Points]

POSTER COMPETITION

- Only 3 participants approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate.
- Participants are required to bring their Poster.

DEBATE COMPETITION

- Only 4 participants approved by their respective authority from each institution can participate. 2 participants should be in favour of the topic and 2 should be against the topic.
- All the other rules shall be told by the organizers on the day of the event.
- Any act of indiscipline will result in the participant being expelled from the competition. In case of Abusive language and indecent behavior, the team will be disqualified.
- Languages used can be Hindi/English.

NUKKAD-NAATAK COMPETITION

- Only one team from each institution approved by their respective authority, comprising of maximum 6 to 8 contestants can participate.
- Maximum time for Street Play should be 6 minutes.
- Teams using any props must bring all their requirements and must be ready well in time as per instructions of the organizer. No Props or any material will be provided by the host. Teams should remove all the props and set items. Only table/ chair may be provided by the organizers.
- Teams can sing / dance by themselves to create the necessary music or sound.
- Teams should have decency and decorum in the behavior, attire and performance. In case of Abusive language and indecent behavior, the team will be disqualified.
- Languages used can be Hindi/English.
