

It took the Indian economy just less than a decade (8 years) to expand from \$1 to \$2 trillion in 2014 and another seven years to reach just under \$3 trillion as of today. In 2019, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced his objective of making India a USD 5 trillion economy by 2024-2025. The underlying advantages pointed to India's ability to attain the stated aim. The structure of the economy and the evolving dynamics in 2019 created the foundation for attaining \$1 trillion in agricultural and related industries, \$1 trillion in manufacturing, and \$3 trillion in services. However, there have been quite a few unexpected events since then. Following a countrywide lockdown due to the aftermath of the

backdrop of the pandemic, and more recently, the Russia-Ukraine war, this economic goal seems exceedingly improbable. According to a 2019 World Bank report, India intends to raise the standard of living of all of its citizens and become a high-middle income nation by 2030. The government is committed to reaching its goal of becoming a \$5 trillion economy by 2024-25. Is it really feasible to achieve this objective? Let's find out 'India a \$5 trillion economy: a myth or reality'?

- ➤ After peer review, the selected papers will be published in edited book with ISBN. Publication charges of ₹1000/- has to be paid separately. All research papers will undergo plagiarism check.


