S.S. Khanna Girls' Degree College has received approval for the four-year B. Ed program.

"S.S. Khanna Girls' Degree College has received approval from the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) to run the four-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP). Under this program, three four-year B.Ed courses will be introduced: B.A. B.Ed, B.Sc. B.Ed, and B.Com. B.Ed."

एसएस खन्ना में अब चार वर्षीय बीएड

उपलब्धि

प्रयागराज, कार्यालय संवाददाता। एसएस खन्ना डिग्री कॉलेज में अब चार वर्षीय बीएड इंटीग्रेटेड (एकीकृत) कोर्स की पढ़ाई शुरू होगी। राष्ट्रीय अञ्चापक शिक्षा परिषद (एनसीटीई) ने कॉलेज की इस कीर्स के संचालन की अनुमति दे दी है। यह अनुमति कुल 150 सीटो पर दी गई है। इस कोर्स में इंटीग्रेटेड शिक्षक शिक्षा कार्यक्रम (आईटीईपी) लागू किया जाएगा, जो एक नया चार वर्षीय शिक्षक प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम है।

इविवि (50 सीटों बीए-बीएड) के बाद संबद्ध महाविद्यालय में चार वर्षीय बीएड की मान्यता पाने वाला पहला कॉलेज हैं।बीएड समन्वयक डॉ. सीम्या कृष्ण ने बताया कि इस चार वर्षीय एनसीटीई ने दी 150 सीटों
 पर संवालन की मंजूरी

 पाने वाला पहला कॉलेज

पाद्यक्रम में बीए-बीएड, बीएससी-बीएड और बीकॉम-बीएड में प्रवेश की सुविधा होगी। तीनों ही कोसों में 50-50 सीटें निर्धारित की गई हैं। नए शैक्षणिक सत्र सेडन पाद्यक्रमों में प्रवेश प्रक्रिया शुरू होगी।

नेशनल टेस्टिंग एजेंसी (एनटीए) की ओर से आयोजित नेशनल कॉमन इंट्रेस टेस्ट (राष्ट्रीय सामान्य प्रवेश परीक्षा) के स्कोर पर प्रवेश होगा। यह पाठ्यक्रम आठ सेमेस्टर का होगा। इसके तीन प्रमुख फायदे हैं। चार साल में बीए-बीएड की पढ़ाई करने के बाद छात्र-छात्राएं पीजीटी (ट्रंड ग्रेजुएट

बाद बीए में शामिल मुख्य विषय से एमए सकेगा। इस (परारनातक) कर पाठ्यक्रम को पुरा करने वाले छात्र को सिर्फ एक साल में एमएड की डिग्री मिल जाएगी। यह एक दोहरी डिग्री कार्यक्रम होगा। जो पूरी तरह से राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (एनईपी-2020) के अनुरूप है। यह पूर्ण रूप से एक व्यावसायिक कार्यक्रम है, जो 100% रोजगार क्षमता प्रदान करता है। प्राचार्या प्रो. लालिमा सिंह ने समस्त शिक्षकों एवं कर्मचारियों को इस उपलब्धि के लिए हार्दिक बधाई दी और बताया कि यह उपलब्धि न केवल महाविद्यालय के लिए, बल्कि प्रयागराज के गौरव का विषय है। यह एक ऐतिहासिक पहल है जो शिक्षकों के निर्माण की दिशा में एक सशक्त और नवीन्मेषी प्रयास के रूप में मानी जाएगी।


