#### Salient Features of Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025

The Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025 was amends the Waqf Act, 1995, allowing the government to regulate Waqf properties and settle related disputes. It aims to improve Waqf board efficiency, update Waqf definitions, streamline registration, and boost use of technology in record management. Waqf refers to an endowment made by a Muslim for charitable or religious purposes, such as building mosques, schools, hospitals, or other public institutions. It is inalienable i.e., it cannot be sold, gifted, inherited or encumbered. The salient features of the Act are as follows-Trusts vs. Waqf: Muslim-created trusts under other laws will not be treated as Waqf, preserving individual ownership and control.

- · Eligibility for Waqf Dedication: Only practicing Muslims for at least 5 years can dedicate property to Waqf.
- Existing Waqf Properties: Already registered properties remain unless disputed or found to be government land.
- · Women's Rights: Women must receive their legal inheritance before any Waqf dedication; special provisions apply for widows, divorced women, and orphans.
- · Section 40 Removed: Waqf Boards can no longer arbitrarily declare properties as Waqf.
- Dispute Resolution: Waqf Tribunals (judge, state officer, Muslim law expert) decisions can be appealed in High Court within 90 days.
- Govt Land Claims: Only senior officers can examine government land claimed as Waqf.
- Reduced Contributions: Waqf institutions' mandatory board contributions cut from 7% to 5%.
- Audit Rules: Institutions earning over Rs 1 lakh annually must undergo State audits.
- · Digital Reforms: A central portal will manage Waqf properties; caretakers must register property details.
- · Inclusive Boards: Boards must include 2 non-Muslims and at least 2 Muslim women; representation from key Muslim communities is ensured.
- Limitation Act: Now applicable to Waqf disputes to curb endless litigation.

The 2025 Act aims to enhance transparency, prevent misuse, and streamline dispute resolution through legal and technological reforms. However, concerns over government control, representation, and property rights must be addressed through dialogue to balance regulatory oversight with community autonomy. The rules for the Waqf (Amendment) Act, 2025 are yet to be released.


## विश्व हिन्दी दिवस 2025


## EXCURSION TO GARHWA FORT AND SILICA MINING AREA OF SHANKARGARH

An excursion of students of Certificate Course on Environmental Studies (B.Sc. I) to Garhwa Fort, Shankargarh was organized by the college on 18th January 2025. This visit aimed at providing the information regarding our heritage and giving them firsthand experience to witness our cultural asset. The visit also included trekking on mountains of Pratappur region which is well known as Silica Mining region of Shankargarh. The coordinators of this add-on course (Dr. Sippy Singh, Dr. Shabnam Praveen, Dr. Sarita Agrawal and Dr. Durgesh Singh) alongwith Dr. A. Rahman, Mr. Shivam Mishra, 3 Non-teaching staff and 52 students went on this tour. The fort is medieval fortified enclosure, housing a temple belonging to Gupta Period. The fort has historical importance as it has stone scriptions of early 5th century by Chandragupta II and Kumargupta. The mountain range of silica mining area, Pratappur was also explored.

#### "Science-Kumbh": Two days Lecture Series & Intercollegiate Poster Competition on Global Health Trends

The "Science-Kumbh", a two-day lecture series on Biotechnology, Bioinformatics, IPR and Molecular techniques organized by the DST CURIE Supported PG Departments of SSKGDC, Prayagraj during 7-9 February, 2025 consisted of a series of lectures and hands-on training sessions on Bioinformatics. The workshop was conducted by the faculty members of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ICGEB), New Delhi, Amity University Gurugram, and All Indian Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi. Prof. Rupesh Chaturvedi in the inaugural session, talked about Intellectual Property Rights, where he described the emerging trends of Bio entrepreneurship, Setting Up start-up companies, and commercialization. Moreover, he explained the mechanism of patenting the biological products and processing. In the following lecture on Biotechnology, Prof Neel Sarovar Bhavesh explained about the history and important contributions of various Scientists who had been involved in cutting-edge discoveries. He also talked about the recent scientific developments in India that will help India to evolve as Vikisit Bharat by 2047. Dr Jaydeep Bharracharya delivered a lecture on microscopy and provided a complete overview on how the development in microscopic techniques revolutionized the Biological Sciences. Dr Ranjita Ghosh Moulik further explained in her lecture, about the important use of UV/Visible and fluorescent spectroscopy in identifying the biological molecules in the solution. The last lecture of day 1, delivered by Dr. Manoj K Sharma was about the plant biotechnology where he delivered a lecture on Agrobacterium-mediated gene transfer and its application in plant sciences. He elaborated on comprehensive methodology for the genetic transformation and its current application in Plant Biotechnology.

On day 2 of the conference, Dr. Ravi Tandon talked about the basics of DNA sequencing and gave a clear picture on the advancement of nucleic acid sequencing from the various generations of DNA sequencing approach that is the backbone of Genomics and molecular biology research. Dr Hemant Ritturaj Kushwaha talked about the evolution of Bioinformatics and data sciences where is gave a clear picture on various bioinformatics tool to predict various biological events. Moreover he discussed how the importance of data sciences and its benefits in current scientific scenarios. His hand on training session after the lecture was very helpful for students to know the application of bioinformatics tools to identify gene and protein similarity and molecular interactions. The last lecture of 2<sup>rd</sup> day lecture series was delivered by Dr Abhinav Kumar from AIIMS, New Delhi, where he talked about the clinical parameters in trauma care and the advances in medical sciences to save the life of patients who are admitted to the trauma centre.

The lecture series received total of 95 registrations that included 76 PG students, 05 Research Scholars, and 14 outsiders, out of which 11 were from SHUATS and 03 students were from University of Allahabad.

In addition, 70 responses were obtained for "Science-Kumbh" Intercollegiate Poster Competition on Global Health Trends from SS Khanna Girls Degree College, SHUATS Naini, Jeevan Jyoti Paramedical Institute Prayagraj, Sanjay Gandhi Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Lucknow, Shri Suresh Chandra Educational institution Bhiti Prayagraj, Iswar saran degree college, University of Allahabad, SHAMBHUNATH INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY Prayagraj, Nand kisorepg college Naini, College of state University, Shalom institute of health and allied sciences nainipryagraj.






## Career Chaupal


