### A Journey of 50 Glorious Years

Sadanlal Sanwaldas Khanna Mahila Mahavidyalaya (S. S. Khanna Girls' Degree College) Prayagraj, a Constituent College of University of Allahabad, was established in the 'International year for Women', 1975, by a group of idealists, Late Prof. Damodardas Khanna, Late Shyam Narain Kapoor, Late. S.N. Kakkar and Late Govind Prasad Khanna. At the inception, the college had the Faculty of Arts and four faculty members. The college was visualized to impart moral, spiritual and nationalist values to girl children belonging to the less empowered sections of the society.

With the tenacious efforts of its founding members, and the steady support of the faculty members, the college gradually evolved to nurture and cultivate the hopes and dreams of innumerable girls, providing them with a suitable space to attain wholesome education, for stepping into the world as competent individuals and proficient citizens.

In its journey of 50 glorious years, the college has grown to be a composite institution wherein now education is being imparted in the faculty of Arts, Science, Commerce, Teacher- Education and Law. Apart from undergraduate courses, the college offers Post Graduate Courses and D.Phil. also. Apart from the regular degree courses, the college also runs various add on courses such as Diploma in Bio-technology, Diploma in Fashion designing, O level and CCC Computer Courses, Certificate Course in German etc. The curriculum delivery is executed with great care through dedicated faculty members (45 permanent, 48 self-financed) so as to ensure maximum output.

The college encourages its students to engage with the community, fosters ideas of eco-awareness, gender sensitization, and assists the students to internalize and assimilate these ideas which shape their future. The college is blessed with a team of donors. As of date, it has a corpus of crores of rupees. The interest generated from the corpus is utilised by the institution to provide freeships, scholarships to needy, single girl child etc, totalling more than 10 Lakh rupees.


**Note : Instruction** - Applicants are not allowed to withdraw Office Management & Secretarial Practices course in 3rd year.

### R.B. MEHROTRA POSTGRADUATE FACULTY


The R.B. Mehrotra Postgraduate faculty has been successfully running PG programme under the self-finance scheme in the following subjects of Faculty of Arts since 2016.



The postgraduate degree has the approval of the University of Allahabad and follows a course structure based on the CBCS (Choice based Credit System) framework where a student has to earn a total of 80 credits in order to be awarded the degree. Students seeking admission in the PG programme have to necessarily take the PGAT (Postgraduate Admission Test) conducted by the University of Allahabad. Admissions will be given in the subject that the student has opted for in PGAT, and on the basis of the PGAT score of the student. Admission forms for the PG programme are available from the college Admission Counter. Students' ABC (Academic Bank of Credit) Id will be generated as per the existing guidelines.

### Research / D.Phil. Course

D. Phil in the following subjects is available in the Faculty of Arts:



Admission to the D. Phil. course takes place through the CRET examination conducted by the University of Allahabad. The students who are allocated seats in the college by their respective departments in the University are then required to take admission in the college. A Research Degree Committee has been established in the College to deal with the issues related to the research programme.

### SAROJ LALJI MEHROTRA SCIENCE FACULTY

The Saroj Lalji Mehrotra Science Faculty, established in 1994-95 with undergraduate programs in Biology and Mathematics, has since experienced remarkable growth in both infrastructure and academics. The faculty in the last decade has expanded to include **postgraduate (PG) courses in 2016-17** and **D.Phil. programs in Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology in 2019-20**.

### **Advancing Undergraduate Science Education**

In 2019-20, the Departments of **Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology** were selected for the strengthening component of the **Star College Scheme** by the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Government of India. This scheme provided crucial financial support to enhance undergraduate science teaching. Students across all three years of the B.Sc. programwere benefited from this initiative, gaining unique exposure to experimental science. This "hands-on" approach fostered critical thinking and improved practical skills in the aforementioned subjects.

The DBT's support significantly boosted student participation in various activities, increased the efficiency of non-teaching staff, led to better laboratory setups, and encouraged greater faculty involvement in academic and extracurricular work. The scheme also ignited a passion for research and networking among both faculty and students, leading to visits to research institutes and industries, and inspiring applications for research grants, preparing them for future challenges.

### A Crowning Achievement: DST-CURIE Scheme

The college's commitment to research and academic excellence was further recognized with its selection under the **DST-CURIE Scheme** ("Consolidation of University Research for Innovation and Excellence in Women Universities"). Under this prestigious scheme, the **Botany, Chemistry, and Zoology** departments received research funding from the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India.

This grant includes non-recurring funds for equipment purchases and recurring grants over three years for the holistic improvement of science education, with a strong emphasis on practical training at the postgraduate and research levels. The CURIE scheme aims to nurture scientific excellence by providing essential infrastructure and facilities for R&D activities in new and emerging areas, and attracting fresh talent to women's educational institutions.

Furthermore, the scheme includes an outreach component, enabling students from other colleges to utilize the college's advanced equipment. The grant will invigorate interdisciplinary research through the upgrade of postgraduate teaching and training laboratories, the development of comprehensive curricula, and the enhancement of hands-on practical training to equip students with expertise in their respective fields. Significantly, S. S. Khanna Girls' Degree College is the first PG college in Prayagraj to receive funding under the CURIE Scheme.

The college extends its deepest gratitude to the Sar-La Education Trust, Mumbai, for their unwavering financial support. Their ongoing annual grant of 20 lakh plays a pivotal role in the successful running of the Saroj Lalji Mehrotra Science Faculty.

- 4. छात्राओं का स्नातक प्रथम, द्वितीय एवं तृतीय वर्ष की परीक्षाओं में अलग-अलग उत्तीर्ण होना अनिवार्य है। परीक्षाफल तीनों वर्ष की परीक्षाओं के प्राप्तांक-योग पर निर्धारित किया जाता है और श्रेणी निश्चित की जाती है। स्नातकोत्तर प्रथम एवं द्वितीय वर्ष, विधि स्नातक/बी.एड. के लिए सभी सेमेस्टर में उत्तीर्ण होना अनिवार्य है। अतः छात्राओं को चाहिए कि प्रतिवर्ष पूर्ण मनोयोग से अध्ययन करें।
- 5. महाविद्यालय के नियम एवं प्राचार्या के आदेशानुसार कार्य करना प्रत्येक छात्रा का कर्तव्य है। इसके लिए छात्रा को समय-समय पर महाविद्यालय सूचनापट्ट, वेबसाइट/वॉट्सएप ग्रुप देखते रहना चाहिए।

## **Diploma in Fashion Designing**

In the academic session of 2020-21, college received approval from the Ministry of Education to launch a one-year diploma program in Fashion Designing, operating within the framework of the National Skill Qualification Framework. The program's central aim is to foster self-reliance and empowerment among students, reflecting a commitment to equipping learners with practical skills alongside theoretical knowledge.

Eligibility for admission to this program requires completion of 10+2 education, with no upper age limit imposed due to its skill-



based nature. This inclusive approach ensures accessibility to a diverse range of aspiring designers, irrespective of academic background or age. The program spans two semesters, providing a comprehensive exploration of fashion design principles and practices.Despite its comprehensive curriculum, the program maintains affordability, with a total fee of 3500 rupees. This nominal fee underscores the commitment to making education accessible and equitable, ensuring that financial constraints do not hinder students' pursuit of their passions in fashion design.

## **Diploma Course in Biotechnology**

A Golden opportunity to obtain one year professional add on Diploma course along with B.Sc. Degree.

In an endeavour to augment the professional abilities, specially of girl students, the College is running an add-on one-year Diploma Course in Biotechnology from the academic session 2009-10. The Diploma course is approved by University Grants Commission under the Career Oriented Scheme and also has been approved by the University of Allahabad. As the diploma is an add-on course therefore can be very well clubbed together with the regular B.Sc. III rd year course. The college run this Diploma course with financial assistance of U.G.C., Saraswat Khatri Pathshala Society and Sar-la Education Trust, Mumbai.

**Eligibility:** III<sup>rd</sup> year B.Sc./ B.Sc. pass out girl's students with Zoology, Botany, Biochemistry and Chemistry combination.

**Duration:** One year (Two semester of six months each)

Intake: 20 students per semester



Admission Procedure: On the basis of marks in previous Examination and personal interview. Reservation in admission rules apply as per Government Provisions.

Job Opportunities: This Diploma course will provide a career in the diagnostic laboratory, pharmaceutical companies, biotech-related companies, food, aquaculture, chemical and allied industries. There is large scale employment in research laboratories run by government as well as the corporate sector.

उपिश्वित एवं अनुशासन (प्रॉक्टोिरयल बोर्ड): पठन—पाठन हेतु अनुकूल वातावरण निर्माण करने की आधारभूत शर्त अनुशासन है। अनुशासन व्यवस्था हेतु प्रॉक्टोिरयल बोर्ड का गठन किया जाता है। सत्र के प्रारम्भ में कला, विज्ञान, वाणिज्य, विधि एवं बी.एड. संकाय की छात्राओं को अकादिमक कैलेन्डर में अंकित तिथियों पर 'प्रॉक्टोिरयल मीट' का आयोजन कर अनुशासन सम्बन्धी नियमों व निर्देशों से तथा नियमों का उल्लंघन करने पर महाविद्यालय द्वारा की जाने वाली अनुशासनात्मक कार्यवाही से अवगत कराया जाता है। प्रॉक्टोिरयल मीट में प्रत्येक छात्रा की उपस्थिति अनिवार्य है। प्रत्येक छात्रा को महाविद्यालय पिरसर में प्राचार्या एवं प्रॉक्टर का हस्ताक्षर युक्त परिचय पत्र पहनना अनिवार्य है। दोपहिया वाहन लाने वाली छात्राओं को टोकन बनवाना, हेलमेट पहनना, वैध डाइविंग लाइसेन्स रखना अनिवार्य है।

अनुशासन व्यवस्था में छात्राओं की भागीदारी सुनिश्चित करने के लिए प्रत्येक वर्ष चुनाव प्रक्रिया द्वारा छात्र परिषद् (स्टूडेन्ट काउंसिल) का गठन किया जाता है। परिषद् में अध्यक्ष, उपाध्यक्ष, सचिव, संयुक्त सचिव, सांस्कृतिक सचिव पदों का चयन छात्रा प्रतिनिधियों द्वारा किया जाता है। छात्राओं को प्रतिनिधि के लिए कार्यालय से प्रोफार्मा प्राप्त कर विधिवत् आपूरित कर निर्धारित तिथि तक जमा करना आवश्यक है।

एंटी रैंगिंग सेल : महाविद्यालय में रैगिंग सम्बन्धी किसी भी प्रकार की गतिविधियाँ सख्त रूप से प्रतिबन्धित है। छात्राओं से अपेक्षा है कि वे रैगिंग सम्बन्धी नियमों की जानकारी www.ugc.ac.in से प्राप्त करें। अनिवार्य रूप से सभी छात्राएं www.antiragging.in या www.amanmovement.org पर जाकर रजिस्ट्रेशन करायें तथा वदसपदम शपथ—पत्र भरें। ऑनलाइन शपथ—पत्र भरने के पश्चात् यू. जी.सी. से प्राप्त एन्टी रैगिंग अण्डर टेकिंग संख्या (Anti-ragging Undertaking Reference No.) सम्बन्धी मेल को निम्नलिखित पते antiraggingssk@gmail.com पर भेज दें। यह प्रक्रिया अनिवार्य है।

विशाखा कम्पलेन्ट कमेटी अगेन्स्ट सेक्सुअल हैरेरमेन्ट : विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग (उच्च शैक्षिक संस्थाओं में महिला कर्मचारी एवं छात्राओं के लैंगिक उत्पीड़न के निराकरण, निषेध एवं इसमें सुधार) विनियम 2015 के अन्तर्गत महाविद्यालय में छात्राओं को सुरक्षित एवं स्वस्थ शैक्षणिक वातावरण उपलब्ध कराने के लिए 'विशाखा कम्प्लेन्ट कमेटी अगेन्स्ट सेक्सुअल हैरेरमेंट' का गठन किया गया है।

वेलनेस सेंटर: महाविद्यालय में छात्राओं की व्यक्तिगत, शैक्षिक एवं अन्य समस्याओं को सुनने एवं निराकरण हेतु वेलनेस सेन्टर है। यह महाविद्यालय का अभिनव प्रयोग है। इस सेन्टर की कोआर्डिनेटर से छात्रायें सम्पर्क करें।

पुस्तकालय निर्देश: फीस रसीद एवं आपूरित परिचय पत्र दिखाकर निर्धारित तिथि के अन्तर्गत छात्रा के लिए लाइब्रेरी कार्ड बनवाना अनिवार्य है। प्रत्येक छात्रा को दो लाइब्रेरी कार्ड दिये जायेंगे जिससे वह पुस्तकें लाइब्रेरी से निर्गत करा सकती है। पन्द्रह दिन के बाद लाइब्रेरी में पुस्तकें वापस करना अनिवार्य है, अन्यथा प्रति पुस्तक एक रूपया प्रतिदिन के हिसाब से विलम्ब शुल्क देय होगा। वार्षिक परीक्षा से पूर्व पुस्तकें वापस कर नो ड्यूज कराना आवश्यक है अन्यथा अंक पत्र नहीं दिया जाएगा और दण्डात्मक कार्यवाही की जाएगी। छात्राएँ परिचय पत्र दिखाकर लाइब्रेरी में समाचार पत्र एवं पत्र—पत्रिकाएँ पढ़ सकती है। लाइब्रेरी में छात्राओं की सहायता के लिए 'बुक बैंक' की सुविधा भी है। छात्राएँ बुक बैंक से सम्पूर्ण सत्र के लिए अधिक से अधिक दो पुस्तकें बिना किसी अतिरिक्त शुल्क के प्राप्त कर सकती है। ई—बुक्स एवं ई—जर्नल्स के अध्ययन के लिए छात्राओं को रिजस्ट्रेशन कराना आवश्यक है। पुस्तकालय में कम से कम मूल्य में फोटोकॉपी सुविधा भी उपलब्ध है।

छात्र कल्याण परिषद : महाविद्यालय में छात्र कल्याण परिषद की स्थापना की गई है। इस परिषद के अन्तर्गत छात्राओं के लिए उपयोगी विविध अकादिमक / सांस्कृतिक / अन्य गतिविधियों को संचालित किया जाता है।

रोजगार परक व्याख्यानों का आयोजन, स्वास्थ्य सम्बन्धी परामर्श की भी व्यवस्था छात्राओं के लिए की जाती है।

गृह परीक्षा: छात्राओं की शैक्षिक प्रगति को मूल्यांकित करने के उद्देश्य से दिसम्बर माह में गृह परीक्षा का आयोजन किया जाता है। प्रत्येक छात्रा के लिए गृह परीक्षा देना अनिवार्य है।

छात्रवृत्ति, आर्थिक सहायता एवं शुल्क मुक्ति : प्रतिभाशाली छात्राओं की मेधा को सम्मानित करने तथा जरूरतमंद छात्राओं को आर्थिक सहायता प्रदान करे के लिए महाविद्यालय में छात्रवृत्ति शुल्क प्रतिपूर्ति की भी व्यवस्था है। इसके अतिरिक्त छात्राओं को कम्प्यूटर, पेन्टिंग, संगीत गायन एवं वादन प्रतिभा को विशेष प्रोत्साहन देने के लिए विशिष्ट छात्रवृत्तियाँ प्रदान की जाती है। महाविद्यालय एवं सारस्वत खत्री पाठशाला सोसायटी द्वारा दी जाने वाली छात्रवृत्तियों की विस्तृत जानकारी छात्राएं महाविद्यालय पत्रिका प्रमा/ विवरणिका/छात्रवृत्ति समिति से प्राप्त कर सकती हैं। छात्रवृत्ति एवं वित्तीय सहायता प्राप्त करने के लिए छात्राओं का वार्षिक परीक्षा में 55% अंक प्राप्त करना तथा कक्षा में 75% उपस्थिति अनिवार्य है। साथ ही महाविद्यालय में या अंयत्र किसी इकाई द्वारा छात्रा के विरूद्ध अनुशासनात्मक कार्यवाही न हुई हो। विशेष जरूरतमंद छात्राओं हेतु महाविद्यालय में च्ववत थ्नदक (निर्धन कोष) की भी व्यवस्था है। उ० प्र० सरकार समाज कल्याण छात्रवृत्ति, भारत सरकार, शिक्षा निदेशालय, श्रम मंत्रालय आदि द्वारा दी जाने वाली छात्रवृत्ति सम्बन्धी विस्तृत जानकारी छात्राएं विवरणिका कार्यालय / समिति से प्राप्त कर सकती हैं। छात्राओं को वार्षिकोत्सव में प्रदान की जाने वाली छात्रवृत्ति के चेक कार्यालय से यथाशीघ्र प्राप्त कर लेना चाहिए। छात्रवृत्ति प्राप्त करने के लिए छात्राओं को अपने बचत खाता पासबुक के प्रथम पृष्ठ की छायाप्रति कार्यालय में जमा करनी होगी। समय–समय पर छात्रवृत्ति सम्बन्धी विशेष सूचना प्राप्त करने के लिए छात्राएं नोटिस बोर्ड अवश्य देखें। किसी भी प्रकार की असुविधा होने पर वे छात्रवृत्ति समिति से सम्पर्क कर सकती हैं।

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना: राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना (एन.एस.एस.) भारत सरकार के युवा एवं खेल मंत्रालय द्वारा संचालित एक केन्द्रीय योजना है। जिसका उद्देश्य सभी युवाओं को सामुदायिक सेवा गतिविधियों एवं कार्यक्रमों में भाग लेने के लिए अवसर प्रदान करना है। राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना का एकमात्र उद्देश्य युवा छात्र—छात्राओं के सर्वांगीण व्यक्तित्व विकास में सहयोग प्रदान करना है।

महाविद्यालय में कुल 4 इकाईयाँ — इकाई संख्या 56, 57, 58 व 59 है। प्रत्येक इकाई में 100 स्वयंसेविकाओं का नामांकन किया जाता है, जिसमें स्वयंसेविकाओं को दो साल की अवधि में कल 240 घंटें की सामाजिक सेवा योगदान करना आवश्यक है। राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना स्वयंसेविकाओं को प्रति वर्ष 20 घंटें उन्मुखीकरण और 100 घंटें सामुदायिक सेवा में देना पड़ता है। सामान्य कार्य में प्रतिभाग करती है। इन 100 स्वयंसेविकाओं में उत्कृष्ट प्रदर्शन करने वाली 50 स्वयंसेविकाओं के साथ राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना द्वारा अधिकृत मिलन बस्तियों में सप्त दिवसीय विशेष शिविर का आयोजन किया जाता है। राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना में स्वयंसेविका के रूप में सहयोग प्रदान करने के लिए इच्छुक छात्रायें कार्यक्रम अधिकारी से सम्पर्क करें।

एन.सी.सी. : महाविद्यालय में एन.सी.सी. यूनिट कार्यरत है। एन.सी.सी. से कैडेट्स को मिलने वाले लाभ इस प्रकार है –

(क) रोजगार में छूट रोजगार के क्षेत्र में केन्द्रीय सरकार कैडेट्स को बहुत सी रियायतें प्रदान करती हैं। 'C' सर्टिफिकेट प्राप्त कैडेट्स को बहुत सी सुविधायें सेना (आर्मी) में दी जाती हैं जो इस प्रकार —

भारतीय सेना अकादमी इण्डियन मिलिट्री एकेडमी (IMA) में 32 रिक्त पद प्रति कोर्स में रिजर्व।

64 नियुक्तियाँ हर साल 'C' सर्टिफिकेट प्राप्त कैडेट्स को जो UPSC और SSB में उत्तीर्ण हैं।

ऑफिसर्स ट्रेनिंग एकेडमी (OTA) प्रतिवर्ष (SSC) शार्ट सर्विस कमीशन में 'C' सार्टिफिकेट प्राप्त कैडेट्स को 50 नियुक्तियाँ देने का प्रावधान है। वे कैडेट्स लिखित परीक्षा न देकर सीधे साक्षात्कार में बुलायें जाते हैं। परन्तु उन्हें एस.एस.बी. (सर्विस सेलेक्शन बोर्ड) में पास होना अनिवार्य है तभी नियुक्ति मिलेगी।

  - (ल) स्टेट गवर्मेन्ट: स्टेट सर्विसेज में वरीयता।
  - (a) उद्योगों में 'C' सर्टिफिकेट प्राप्त को वरीयता दी जाती है।
- 1. अकादिमक क्षेत्र में रियायत—राज्य सरकारों द्वारा पॉलिटेक्निक, आई.टी.आई. इंजीनियरिंग, मेडिकल भर्ती में छूट।
- 2. युवा एक्सचेंज कार्यक्रम—अन्तर्राष्ट्रीय समझौते एवं जागरूकता को बढ़ाने की दृष्टि से एन.सी.सी. के पास युवा संगठन के साथ एक अपूर्व एक्सचेंज कार्यक्रम है जिसके तहत चयनित कैडेटों को विभिन्न देश जैसे ऑस्ट्रेलिया, संयुक्त राष्ट्र, बांग्लादेश, भूटान, कनाडा, मालदीव, नेपाल, सिंगापुर, श्रीलंका और वियतनाम आदि देशों में भी घूमने का अवसर मिलता है।

रंजर: महाविद्यालय में रंजर यूनिट कार्यरत है।

खेलकूद: महाविद्यालय में क्रीड़ा से सम्बन्धित चार हाउस हैं— यलो हाउस, ग्रीन हाउस, रेड हाउस एवं ब्लू हाउस। नव प्रविष्ट छात्राओं को परिचय पत्र दिखाकर सम्बद्ध समिति द्वारा 'हाउस नामांकन' करा लेना चाहिए।

कम्प्यूटर : छात्राओं के स्वावलम्बन तथा व्यावसायिक प्रशिक्षण की दिशा में महाविद्यालय द्वारा कम्प्यूटर प्रशिक्षण की दीर्घ योजना का संकल्प है। यह योजना ख्याति प्राप्त कम्प्यूटर संस्था UPTEC के सहयोग से क्रियान्वित की जाती है। कम्प्यूटर प्रशिक्षण के लिए निर्धन एवं मेधावी छात्राओं को आर्थिक सहायता / छात्रवृत्ति महाविद्यालय द्वारा (लगभग रु० 1 लाख धनराशि) प्रदान की जाती है।

स्पोकेन इंग्लिश प्रोग्राम : महाविद्यालय द्वारा Spoken English का कोर्स भी संचालित किया जाता है।

कैरियर काउसिंलिंग कंसल्टेन्सी एवं प्लेसमेन्ट सेल : महाविद्यालय में छात्राओं के करियर के उचित मार्गदर्शन के लिए कैरियर काउसिंलिंग कंसल्टेन्सी एवं प्लेसमेन्ट सेल का गठन किया गया है। सेल के माध्यम से छात्राओं को रोजगार से सम्बन्धित जानकारी व कैंपस सेलेक्शन, ट्रेनिंग प्रोग्राम इत्यादि के अवसर प्रदान किये जाते हैं।

परिषद् : महाविद्यालय में पाठ्यक्रम के अलावा छात्राओं के सर्वांगीण विकास एवं सहयोगी विषयों के ज्ञान को उन्नत बनाने के लिए विभिन्न परिषदों का गठन किया गया है, जैसे—सामाजिक विज्ञान परिषद्, साहित्य परिषद्, विज्ञान परिषद्, इतिहास परिषद्, संगीत परिषद् एवं वाणिज्य परिषद्। इन परिषदों द्वारा समय—समय पर विविध प्रकार के कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन किया जाता है।

महिला प्रकोष्ठ : महाविद्यालय में छात्राओं को सशक्त बनाने एवं उनके अस्तित्व के उचित सचेष्टता के लिए महिला प्रकोष्ठ का निर्माण किया गया है। सेल द्वारा यथासमय महिला अधिकारों के प्रति जागरूकता सम्बन्धी कार्यक्रम कराये जाते हैं।

अकादिमक एवं सांस्कृतिक क्रियाकलाप : छात्राओं को विभिन्न पाठ्यसहगामी विकासोन्मुख क्रियाकलापओं से जोड़ने तथा उनके मानसिक विकास के लिए इस समिति का गठन किया गया है।

महाविद्यालय पत्रिका: छात्राओं की सृजनात्मक प्रतिभा को विकसित करने तथा विचारों के विस्तार के लिए प्रतिवर्ष महाविद्यालय—पत्रिका 'प्रमा' का प्रकाशन किया जाता है।

रवास्थ्य सेवा प्रकोष्ट : महाविद्यालय में स्वास्थ्य सेवा प्रकोष्ट संचालित है जिसके अन्तर्गत छात्राओं को स्वास्थ्य के प्रति जागरूक करने के लिए विभिन्न कार्यक्रमों का आयोजन किया जाता है। महिला चिकित्सक द्वारा उनके स्वास्थ्य की जांच व प्राथमिक चिकित्सा की भी सुविधा है। शैक्षिक भ्रमण : महाविद्यालय प्रतिवर्ष शैक्षिक भ्रमण की भी व्यवस्था करता है।

विस्तार कार्य समिति : यू.जी.सी. के नीति के अनुसार औपचारिक शिक्षा का लाभ समुदायों तक पहुँचाने के लिए महाविद्यालय में विस्तार समिति की स्थापना की गयी है। इस समिति का उद्देश्य समुदाय और शैक्षणिक संस्थाओं के बीच सम्बन्ध स्थापित करना है जिससे छात्राओं द्वारा जनसंख्या के विभिन्न वर्गों में सामाजिक अधिकारों और दायित्वों और समस्याओं के प्रति जागरूकता का प्रसार किया जा सके। इस समिति का मुख्य ध्येय छात्राओं को उनके सामाजिक दायित्व के प्रति संवेदनशील बनाना है। महाविद्यालय की सभी छात्राएँ स्वतः इस समिति की सदस्य होती है। कॉलेज के प्रत्येक संकाय से एक शिक्षक और एक छात्रा को प्रतिनिधि के रूप में रखा गया है।

पुरा छात्रा संगठन : महाविद्यालय में पुरा छात्रा परिषद 'पुनर्सन्धानम्' का गठन किया गया है। स्नातक/परास्नातक/शोध छात्रा अन्तिम वर्ष का परीक्षाफल आने के बाद छात्राएं पुरा छात्रा परिषद् में रु० 100/—रिजस्ट्रेशन शुल्क अपने संकाय के कार्यालय में जमा करके, अपना नामांकन कराकर सदस्य बन सकती है।

पर्यावरण क्लब: महाविद्यालय में 'पर्यावरण क्लब' के अन्तर्गत अनेक गतिविधियों का आयोजन किया जाता है। इसके माध्यम से छात्राओं में पर्यावरण के प्रति जागरूकता विकसित की जाती है। शिक्षक—अभिभावक संघ: महाविद्यालय में शिक्षक—अभिभावक संघ का गठन किया गया है। शिक्षक— अभिभावक संघ की बैठक आयोजित कर छात्राओं और अभिभावकों से जुड़ी समस्याओं को सामने लाकर महाविद्यालय द्वारा उनका निस्तारण किया जाना है।

केंटीन : महाविद्यालय परिसर में केंटीन की व्यवस्था है। समय—समय पर केंटीन की खाद्य वस्तुओं का परीक्षण एवं मूल्य निर्धारण भी कराया जाता है।

वाहन स्टैण्ड: जो छात्राएं साइकिल / मोपेड / स्कूटर इत्यादि वाहन लाती हैं, उनको महाविद्यालय काउन्टर पर साइकिल 100 / — (एक सौ) और मोपेड / स्कूटर के लिए 200 / — (दो सौ) मात्र फीस जमा कर टोकेन प्राप्त करना अनिवार्य है। यह टोकन वाहन पर लगाना अनिवार्य है अन्यथा उनका पंजीकरण नहीं माना जाएगा। यदि टोकेन खो जाए, तो छात्रा को पुनः निर्धारित शुल्क जमाकर दूसरा टोकेन बनवा लेना चाहिए।

इंस्टीट्यूशनल इनोवेशन सेल: सत्र 2022—23 में, इनोवेशन सेल, शिक्षा मंत्रालय (MIC) के दिशा—निर्देशों के अनुसार, इनोवेशन और स्टार्ट अप इकोसिस्टम की संस्कृति को व्यवस्थित रूप से बढ़ावा देने के लिए महाविद्यालय में इनोवेशन काउंसिल (SSKIIC) की स्थापना हुई है। जिसका उद्देश्य छात्रों में क्रिटिकल थिंकिंग, डिजाइन थिंकिंग, अभिनव विचार प्रक्रिया और उद्यमी मानसिकता जैसे कौशल विकसित करना है।

एस. एस. खन्ना महिला महाविद्यालय का चयन भारत सरकार के शिक्षा मंत्रालय (MoE) द्वारा संचालित कार्यक्रम, उन्नत भारत अभियान (UBA) के अंतर्गत सहभागी संस्था (PI) के रूप में किया गया है। जिसमें कॉलेज बहादुर ब्लाक के पांच गाँव क्रमशः बनी, दलापुर, दुबावल उपरहार, जमुनीपुर और ककरा उपरहार को डी. एम. की अनुमित और सहयोग से उन्नत भारत अभियान (UBA) स्कीम के अंतर्गत अधिकृत रूप से गोद लेगा। इसके लिए कॉलेज को शिक्षा मंत्रालय द्वारा 50,000 रुपये की सीड फंडिंग भी दी जाएगी।

एस.एस. खन्ना महिला महाविद्यालय सत्र 2025–26 की कला, विज्ञान, वाणिज्य एवं बी.एड. तथा विधि संकाय की स्नातक एवं परास्नातक नियमित (Regular) छात्राओं को सूचित किया जाता है कि दशमोत्तर छात्रवृत्ति योजना (दशम् संशोधन) नियमावली–2021 के नियम 6 के अनुसार समाज कल्याण विभाग, उ0 प्र0 द्वारा प्रदत्त दशमोत्तर छात्रवृत्ति एवं शुल्क प्रतिपूर्ति हेतु ऑनलाइन आवेदन करने के लिए छात्रा की न्यूनतम 75% उपस्थिति अनिवार्य है। 75% से कम उपस्थिति वाली छात्राएं छात्रवृत्ति हेतु पात्र नहीं होंगी तथा यदि किसी कारणवश भुगतान हो गई तो भुगतान की गई धनराशि छात्रा को वापस करनी होगी।

उपस्थिति हेतु महाविद्यालय के सभी संकाय में बायोमेट्रिक मशीन लगायी गई है। यह छात्राओं की जिम्मेदारी है कि वे अनिवार्य रूप से उपस्थिति दर्ज कराएं। छात्रा की उपस्थिति न्यूनतम 75% होने पर ही दशमोत्तर छात्रवृत्ति/शुल्क प्रतिपूर्ति आवेदन महाविद्यालय द्वारा स्वीकार/अग्रसारित किया जायेगा। 75% से कम उपस्थिति होने पर आवेदन न कर सकने की पूरी जिम्मेदारी स्वयं छात्रा की ही होगी।
